| PRODUCTION | 8,8 hectares |
| SOIL | Clay topsoil over sandy gravel |
| GRAPE VARIETIES | Merlot 85% and Petit Verdot 15% |
| AGE OF THE VINES | 16 years old |
| DENSITY FARMING | 5,000 feet /hectare |
| METHOD | Sustainable viticulture with tillage and grass cover |
| PRUNING PRACTICE | Guyot mixt with disbudding |
| WORKS | Soil ploughing, organic fertilization Ventilation of vegetation: manual trimming, leaf stripping and cluster thinning Voluntary crop limitation |
| HARVESTING | Manuals in small crates for young vines and partly mechanical with manual sorting on tables |
| VINIFICATION | Fermentation in stainless steel vats Pumping over Extented maceration at 28°-30° C Vatting period of 10 to 16 days |
| AGING | 12 months with French newoak wood |
